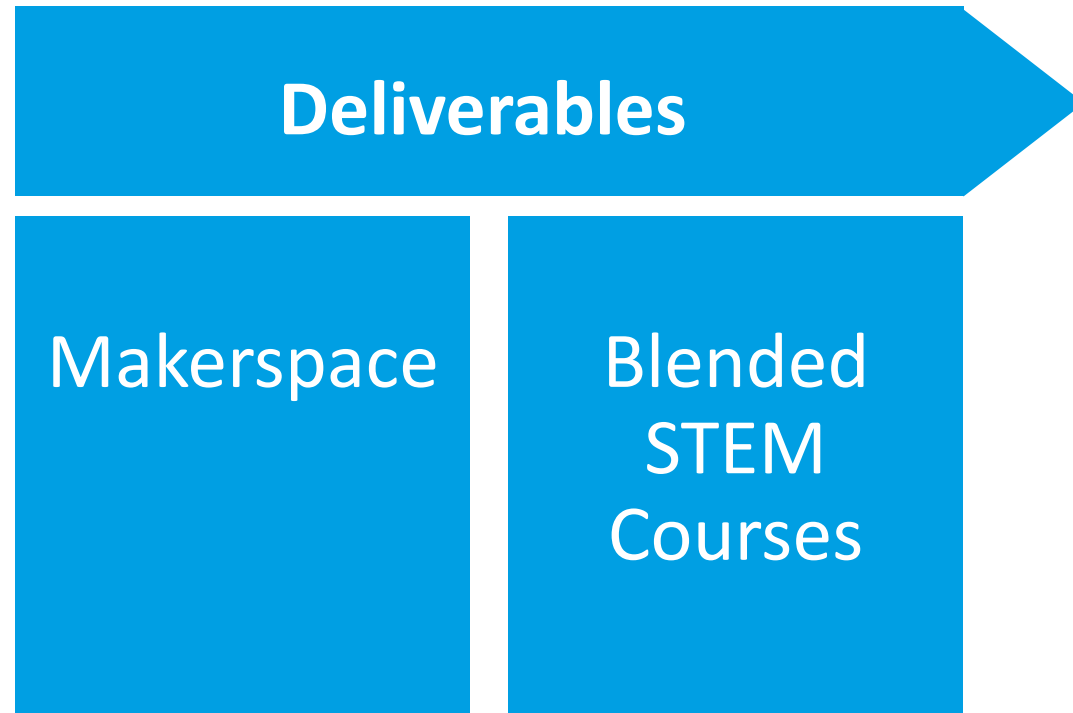

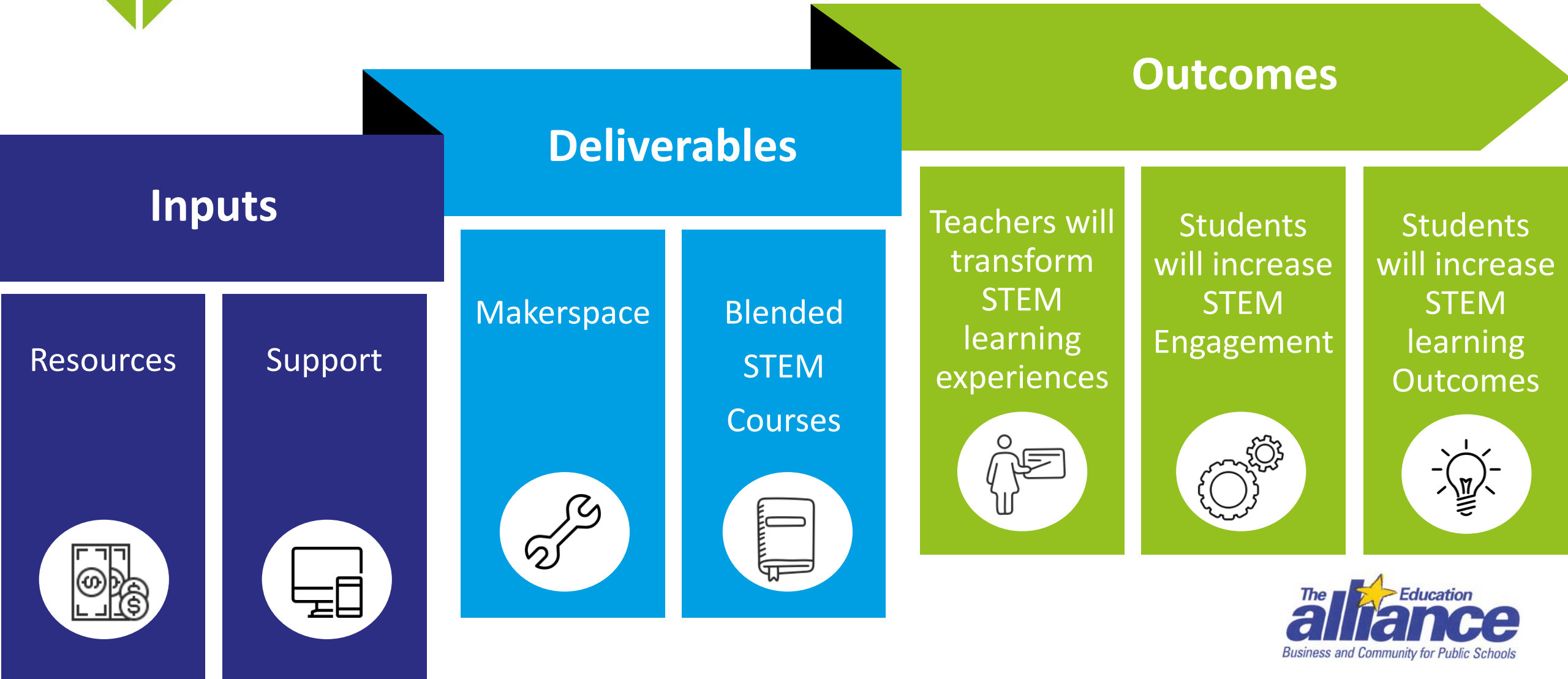

- Evaluate Program Impact



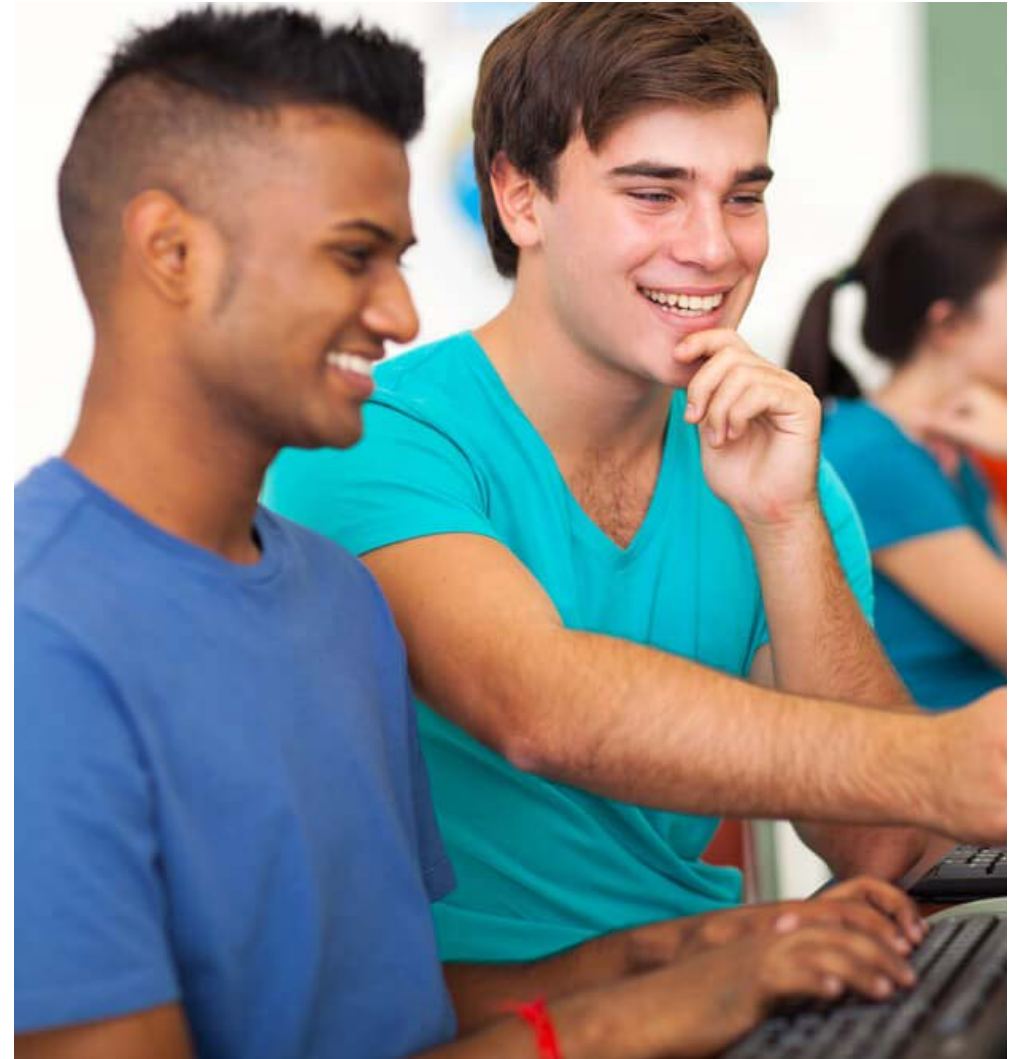
## Phase III: "Sustainability" (Fall 2019 - Spring 2020)

# 2018-19 Expectations

- **QUANTITY:** 1 “Blended Course” = minimum of 4 lessons in LMS
- **QUALITY:** Spring Peer Review of Course Organization, DOK, TIMS

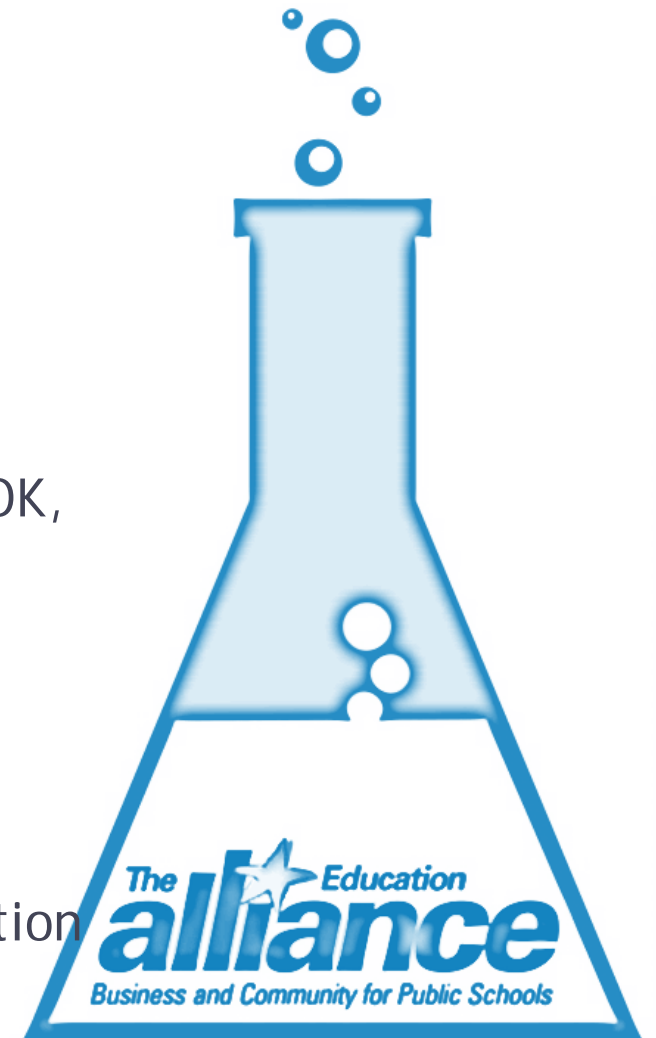
