- Join the weekly 1 hour virtual job shadowing/training modules



Full

- Weekly job shadow modules + Matched with 1 business for full semester
- Support students with capstone project
- Engage in weekly mentoring calls

Job Shadow Training Module

- 30 minute virtual tour of company, introduction to key staff and career opportunities.
- 30 minute training on company HR skill.

Weekly Mentoring Calls

- Business leader mentors a class of students once a week for 15-30 minutes.
- The Education Alliance help mentors facilitate group discussions with students.
- Mentoring calls support students as they work on the capstone project and help build understanding of career pathways within the business.

Capstone Project

- Business assigns a challenge.
- Students work in teams to solve the challenge and present their ideas to the business at the end of the course.
- Teachers help facilitate the capstone project and guide students to find solutions using design thinking.
